Things to Bring

- ☺ Alarm clock (with battery back up)
- ☺ Backpack/book bag
- ☺ Bath towels, bathmat

- ☺ Cleaning supplies (mop, toilet brush, disinfectant/cleaning wipes)
- ☺ Camera
- ☺ Computer (with power strip with surge protection)
- ☺ Dinnerware and utensils
- ☺ Entertainment – TV, video games, playing cards, DVD/VCR
- ☺ Flashlight
- ☺ Hangers
- ☺ Health Insurance Information
- ☺ Message board for room door
- ☺ 3M Command or other removable stickers or hooks
- ☺ Laundry basket or bag, detergent, stain remover
- ☺ Pillow and bed linens for extra long 80”x36” mattress
- ☺ Power strips with surge protection (other extension cords are not allowed)
- ☺ Toilet Paper
- ☺ Trash can and bags - small bedroom size
- ☺ UL approved coffee pots, irons and curling irons with automatic shut off
- ☺ Umbrella and rain gear
- ☺ Calendar or planner for scheduling

Please Leave the following Things at Home

- ☼ Industrial Strength Stereos and Other Sound Amplification Devices
- ☼ Expensive Jewels and Collectibles
- ☼ Any Direct Heat Source such as Hot Plate, Toaster Oven, Electric Skillet, George Forman Grill, Toaster, Electric Frying Pan, Deep Fryer, Microwave Oven or Refrigerator (other than those provided by the university)
- ☼ Extension cords and multi-plug adaptors
- ☼ Dart Boards
- ☼ Flammable Liquids or Chemicals
- ☼ Pets-except fish in a 10 gallon tank or less.
- ☼ Traffic Signs
- ☼ Alcohol/ Alcohol Beverage Container Display
- ☼ Any Fuel Powered Equipment
- ☼ Fire Arms, Hunting Knives, Cross Bows, Pellet Gun, Martial Arts Equipment
- ☼ Water Bed
- ☼ Candles, Incense and plug in air freshners
- ☼ Ceiling Fans

- ☼ Halogen Lamps
- ☼ Fireworks
- ☼ Heaters
- ☼ Pressurized Items (ex: scuba equipment or CO2 canisters)
- ☼ Wireless computer routers
- ☼ Nails, duct tape, double sided foam tape and other adhesives or hooks that will mark or damage the walls.
